Read Luke 24:13-35

- 1. The two men are walking and talking, what changes in v.17?
- 2. How does the resurrected Lord reveal himself in v. 32?

Read Luke 10:38-42

- 3. What was Mary's focus in v.39? Martha's in v. 40?
- 4. In hosting is your aim to serve or to impress?
- 5. What things or 'anxieties' distract you from the word of God?

Read Luke 24:30-31, 35

- 6. What does v. 35 tell us about Jesus?
- 7. Quote: 'Christ is known in community, in small intimate communities of light.'

- 8. What is your home group like? What is your family like? What are bbqs and parties like at your house?
- 9. God was dead but on the third day he rose again. What does this tell us about hope?
